**No Boating** - All boating activities are prohibited. **No motorboats** - Use of paddles, oars, and electric trolling motors is allowed. **Moorings** - No occupied vessel, boat, or other type structure may be tied, beached, moored or otherwise anchored overnight. *See numbered notes and a key to "Other Restrictions" on the next page.*

## Restricted Areas and Other Restrictions

1. Bellamy Reservoir: No boating or any other activity within 4,000 feet of the water supply intake. No boating area is south of the large island. There is a sign located at the dam.
2. Bradley Lake: No fishing or swimming allowed south of the overhead power lines that cross the lake. Boat motor restrictions: RSA 270:114 Bradley Lake. – No person shall use or operate any petroleum-powered boat equipped with any type of petroleum-powered motor in excess of 30 horsepower upon Bradley Lake in the town of Andover. Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a violation.
3. Canaan Street Lake: No boating or any other activities in the southern cove, east of the boat ramp, marked by a stone jetty on the eastern shore and four buoys with signs. Boating restrictions: RSA 270:113 Canaan Street Lake. – No person shall use or operate a ski craft, as defined in RSA 270:73, V, or a hovercraft, as defined in RSA 270:2, VIII, on Canaan Street Lake in the town of Canaan.
4. Canobie Lake: No water-skiing or jet skis allowed. No water contact activities.
5. Goffstown Reservoirs and Whittle Brook: Restrictions do not include Uncanoonuc Lake.
6. Lake Sunapee: No seaplanes in Sunapee Harbor north and west of a line from Russell Point bearing south 45 degrees west to the opposite shore.
7. Lake Waukewan: No swimming, water-skiing, or similar water-contact activities within 400 feet of the public water supply intake. Area is presently not marked.
8. Loon Pond (Hillsborough): No swimming within ¼ mile of the public water supply intake. No ice fishing.
9. Massabesic Lake: No boating on West Pond, area marked by floats and signs. No boating on Mill Pond. No sunfish, sailfish, sailboard, wet sailor type boat, jet ski, water-skiing, or other water-contact recreation. Maximum speed limit is 35 mph; no racing allowed.
10. Paugus Bay: Restricted area (approximately 1,000 feet from the intakes) is marked by a 4'x8' sign that reads: "RESTRICTED AREA-WATER SUPPLY." No boat washing, ice fishing from bob houses, swimming, water skiing, or other water-contact recreation within that area.
11. Penacook Lake: from City of Concord Code of Ordinances: 9-2-1 - Penacook Lake Closed to Recreational Uses. Penacook Lake, formerly known as Long Pond and Forge Pond, together with all lands and adjoining said lake and owned by the City of Concord, are hereby closed to all recreational activities, including hunting, fishing, boating, hiking, camping and picnicking.
12. Upper Beech Pond, from Town of Wolfeboro Code of Ordinances: 167:1-A. Water Purity at Upper Beech Pond. No trespassing on the town-owned land around said pond will be allowed. This includes, but is not limited to, hiking, camping, picnicking, horseback riding or use of any off-highway recreational vehicles at any time.
